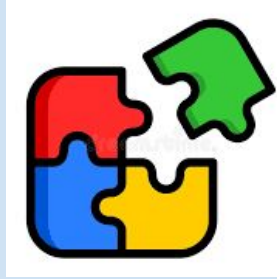

My work experience at a medical clinic helped develop the following skills at the age of 14 and exposed me to new perspectives.



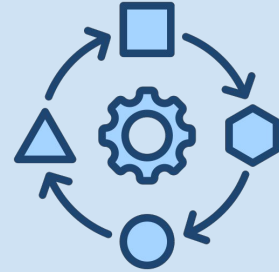
